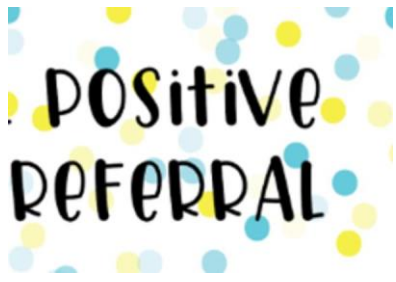

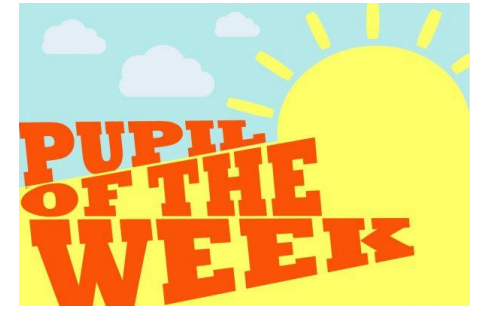
Maths - Mr Kissack - well done for continuing to work well in Maths. You always make sure you get through all of the work set and attempt the challenges. Well done.
