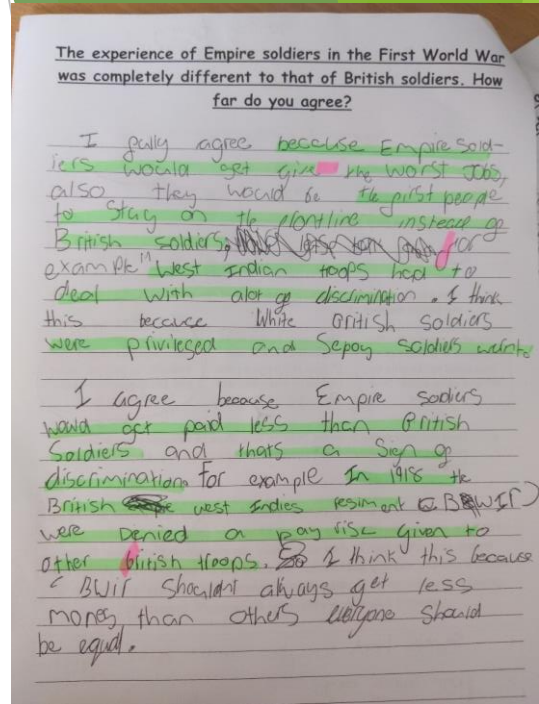


Shout out to....
